<p>CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT NO. 3 Proposed by Initiative Petition</p> <p>Do you want to amend the Missouri Constitution to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">remove state prohibitions on purchasing, possessing, consuming, using, delivering, manufacturing, and selling marijuana for personal use for adults over the age of twenty-one;require a registration card for personal cultivation with prescribed limits;allow persons with certain marijuana-related non-violent offenses to petition for release from incarceration or parole and probation and have records expunged;establish a lottery selection process to award licenses and certificates;issue equally distributed licenses to each congressional district; andimpose a six percent tax on the retail price of marijuana to benefit various programs? <p>State governmental entities estimate initial costs of \$3.1 million, initial revenues of at least \$7.9 million, annual costs of \$5.5 million, and annual revenues of at least \$40.8 million.
